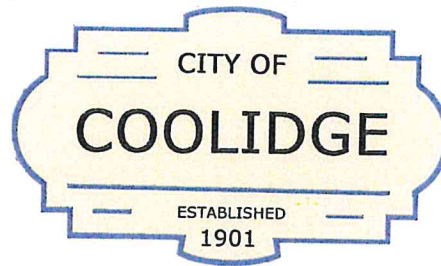

City of Coolidge Winter Storm Advisory Update

Date: January 21, 2025

The City of Coolidge is actively monitoring the incoming winter storm expected to impact our area. Please review the following important updates:

Weather Forecast

- **Tuesday (3:00 PM - 7:00 PM):** Anticipated rainfall of 1-2 inches. Overnight, freezing temperatures may lead to the formation of black ice on roadways.
- **Tuesday Night:** Snow accumulation of 2-4 inches is possible.
- **Wednesday Morning:** Expect extremely cold temperatures with roads likely covered in ice. Temperatures are forecasted to rise during the day, potentially creating slush on roads.

City Services

- **City Hall will closed at 12:30 pm on Tuesday, 01/21/25, will be closed Wednesday, 1/22/2025 and will reopen Thursday 1/23/2025 at 11:00am.**
- There may be delays in city services, including public works garbage collection, due to weather conditions and emergency operations.

Travel Safety

- Roads may become hazardous due to ice and snow. Avoid unnecessary travel, and exercise caution if travel is essential.

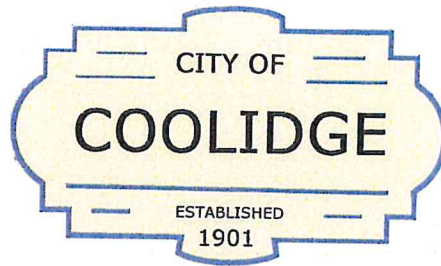
Power Outages
