

City of Coolidge, GA Council Meeting

April 14, 2026

Summary of Actions

- Ensure council members review the drafted manufactured home moratorium resolution before the May meeting and come prepared with questions or comments.
- If the GEFA grant application for replacing galvanized water service lines is approved, coordinate with Water Engineering and staff to use the awarded funds to complete replacement of the approximately 90 affected galvanized service lines.
- On Monday, April 27 at 8:00 a.m., conduct the public opening of all sealed bids received for the city's projects.
- Implement the approved Spring Clean Week activities from April 20–25, including organizing and executing the designated cleanup efforts across the city.
- Conduct the planned cardboard recycling week from April 13–17, including coordinating collection and transportation of cardboard to the Thomasville Recycling Center.
- Be physically present at Coolidge City Hall on Saturday for the Hands-On Thomas County 'manna drop' event and arrive on Thursday to assist with preparations.
- After sending the second round of delinquent tax notices, review the remaining unpaid taxes balance and report back to the council on options for collecting the outstanding \$32,582.
- Host the first community identity theft prevention class at Coolidge City Hall next Tuesday, targeting residents such as seniors who are vulnerable to fraud.
- Begin targeted enforcement patrols in residential neighborhoods to address excessive loud music noise complaints, aiming to reduce disturbances while state law changes are pending.
- Continuing identifying nuisance properties that are unsafe for human habitation, initiate complaint-based enforcement actions against them, and pursue condemnation where rehabilitation is not feasible.
- Prepare and set up the barricade layout for the Hands-On Thomas County 'manna drop' event at Coolidge City Hall on Saturday, ensuring a drive-through configuration with bags delivered directly to vehicles.
